FACTS

- Breast cancer accounts for 30% of all new female cancers each year.
- There is a 1 in 8 chance a woman will develop breast cancer sometime in her lifetime.
- Breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer in women.
- The psychological dysfunction rate in female breast cancer patients was found to range from 30-47%
- There are more than 4 million breast cancer survivors in the United States.
- When breast cancer is detected early the 5 year relative survival rate is 99%.

- Symptoms of breast cancer include: swelling in the breast area, breast or nipple pain, irritation on breast skin, and nipple discharge.
